Berwick Health and Wellness Fund Announces “Innovation & Collaboration” grant opportunity.

Berwick - The Central Susquehanna Community Foundation is pleased to announce information regarding the 2019 “Innovation & Collaboration” grant opportunity available through the Berwick Health & Wellness Fund (BHWF). This grant round begins now and will continue through May 2019.

The “Innovation & Collaboration Grant” is a vehicle to enable continued growth and strengthening of the BHWF service area on a broad scale. BHWF will provide one grant, up to \$50,000, to fund a new project that provides an opportunity to transform an aspect of individual and community health and wellness in the BHWF service area. This grant award will support implementation of emerging ideas, initiatives and/or new collaborations that can substantially impact or provide measurable progress toward solving a significant challenge related to health and wellness in our community. There are grant guidelines specific to this opportunity available at www.csgiving.org.

Grant applications will be completed and submitted through the Foundation’s grant website. First-time applicants are required to attend a grant workshop, specific to this opportunity, prior to beginning the application process. If your organization has applied in the past, the workshop is optional.

Grant requests must be submitted online by 11:59 pm, April 23, 2019.

To be eligible to receive a grant from the Foundation, an organization must hold a 501(c)(3) nonprofit status or be a governmental organization. All grants must benefit the residents and communities within the defined BHWF geographic boundaries. **Individuals are not eligible to apply.** If your organization’s office is outside of the Berwick Health and Wellness service area, you may still apply if you will be serving residents within the Fund’s service area.
