STRENGTHENING COMMUNITY CONNECTIONS COMMUNITY GIVING FOUNDATION: SUNBURY

The Sunbury Area Health Foundation was formed in 2005 out of the sale of the Sunbury Hospital. With more than \$3 million in assets from the sale, the goal of the Foundation was to improve healthcare in the Sunbury region. The Foundation affiliated with the Central Susquehanna Community Foundation (now Community Giving Foundation) in 2006 for investment, development, and back-office support. The next year, Sunbury awarded its first grant to A Community Clinic, a nonprofit medical clinic in Sunbury.

Grant investments from the Foundation supported programs and projects focused on children's health, oral health, coronary care, and issues regarding the working poor. Organizations in the Sunbury Hospital's original footprint— Line Mountain, Selinsgrove, and Shikellamy School Districts—were eligible. After affiliating in 2006, Sunbury continued to provide for these healthcare needs, while also expanding its mission to meet other charitable needs in the greater Sunbury area. The group officially changed its name to the Sunbury Area Community Foundation in 2010 to recognize its broader mission.

Today, Community Giving Foundation: Sunbury continues to assist and encourage donors of all levels to achieve their diverse philanthropic interests. In 2022, Sunbury's 25 charitable funds granted over \$230,000 to local nonprofit organizations and awarded over \$50,000 in scholarships to area students. Through historic and new connections in the greater Sunbury area, the Foundation continues to grow meaningful impact both now and for years to come.
