The Community Giving Foundation would like to thank you for allowing your student to participate in the Youth in Philanthropy program. We are looking forward to an exciting school year!

This year a milestone **twenty local school groups** will be participating in the program! Each school's Youth in Philanthropy group is given up to \$5,000 to disburse to community and school organizations that benefit youth issues. This initiative is funded by endowment funds of the Community Foundation as well as individual and business contributions. There are two components of the program. The first is philanthropy and grant making. The second focus is understanding volunteerism and community service. In addition to awarding grants, students learn what a community foundation is all about and the importance of nonprofit organizations in the community. Student meetings are held at their school and at the Community Giving Foundation Office as well as other nonprofit organizations in the community. Throughout the year, students assess youth needs, gain knowledge of local nonprofits, award grants, practice general meeting skills, and take steps to become a philanthropist.

In addition to our regular program we have partnered with The **Lilly Family School of Philanthropy** for this year's kickoff, whose mission is to increase understanding of philanthropy and generosity around the world through multidisciplinary research, transformational education, professional development, professional practices, and active engagement.
